New Content Added: Prepaid Accounts

A new topic, <u>Prepaid Accounts</u> has been added in the <u>Account channel</u>. Effective on April 1, 2019, Regulation E and Regulation Z were both expanded to provide coverage and certain consumer protections to prepaid accounts, which include payroll card accounts, government benefit accounts, and certain other types of prepaid products. This new topic covers the expanded rules.

NCUA: Registration Open for CURE Initiatives Webinar

<u>Online registration</u> is open for an April 24 webinar discussing programs and initiatives the NCUA's Office of Credit Union Resources and Expansion has planned for 2019. The webinar, "What's Happening in CURE for 2019," is scheduled to begin at 2 p.m. Eastern (8 a.m. HST) and run approximately 60 minutes. Participants will be able to log into the webinar and view it on mobile devices using the registration link, and they should allow pop-ups from this website.

CFPB: 2018 HMDA Modified Loan Application Registers Data Published

The Bureau announced that the HMDA modified loan/application register (LAR) is available for each institution that filed HMDA data collected in 2018. The modified LARs provide each financial institution's loan-level HMDA data, as modified to protect applicant and borrower privacy in accordance with the Bureau's <u>policy guidance</u> on disclosure of the HMDA data. <u>Click here</u> for the modified LARs.

CFPB: Bill Calendar - Know What You Owe and When it's Due (Educate Your Members)

Do you find yourself surprised by bills or unsure if you'll have enough money to cover them each month? It's important to remember that you're still in control of your finances and budget, even when bills are piling up.

Most people have regular obligations like rent, utilities, car payments, and insurance payments. These usually have a fixed due date and if you're late, you'll likely pay a fee and risk a negative entry in your credit history.

The first step to staying on budget is to know what you owe and where your money goes. If you're not able to make ends meet at the end of the month, the timing of your income and expenses may be off. A <u>bill calendar</u> helps you budget for the entire month by tracking when your bills are due.

Change Due on MLA Website

A notice has been posted on the Department of Defense Military Lending Act (MLA) website that the site will be upgraded to version 4.9 on Tuesday, April 9. As a result of this upgrade, Name fields (First, Middle, and Last) will no longer accept numeric characters. Users can only enter Alphabetic characters, spaces, dashes, and apostrophes in the Name fields. This change was implemented as an additional security measure. The notice indicates users should not experience any down time during this release.

IC3: Chinese Embassy Scam

The Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3) has received multiple complaints from victims who were contacted via phone, text or other chat application by individuals speaking a Chinese dialect and claiming to be from the Chinese embassy or consulate. Other victims reported being contacted by individuals claiming to be from a shipping company stating there is a package waiting for the victim at the Chinese embassy. The phone calls are frequently spoofed in order to appear from a legitimate source.

In some variations of this scam, victims may be first told that a suspicious document, package,

*Claim for Exemption: Real Property Assessment City & County of Honolulu *Claim for Exemption: Real Property Assessment - County of Kauai or person was found or detained, usually at an airport located in China. The person on the phone claims the victim's passport, social security card, or credit card was found to be in the package or on the suspicious person. Victims are then told they are under investigation and, in order to assist Chinese law enforcement, they must speak to an investigator.

- <u>MS-ISAC Releases Security Primer on LockerGoga Ransomware</u>: The Multi-State Information Sharing & Analysis Center (MS-ISAC) has released a Security Primer on LockerGoga Ransomware—a type of malicious software, or malware, designed to deny access to a computer system or data until a ransom is paid.
- <u>VMware Releases Security Updates</u>: VMware released security updates to address vulnerabilities in multiple products. The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) encourages users and administrators to review the VMware Security Advisories <u>VMSA-2019-0004</u> and <u>VMSA-2019-0005</u> and apply the necessary updates.
- <u>Cisco Releases Security Update for Cisco IOS XE</u>: Cisco released a security update to address a vulnerability in Cisco IOS XE. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the <u>Cisco Security Advisory</u> and apply the necessary update.
- <u>Cisco Releases Security Updates for Multiple Products</u>: Cisco released security updates to address vulnerabilities in multiple Cisco products. CISA encourages users and administrators to review the <u>Cisco Security Advisory page</u> and apply the necessary updates.
- <u>ASUS Releases Security Update for Live Update Software</u>: ASUS released Live Update version 3.6.8. This version addresses vulnerabilities that a remote attacker could exploit to take control of an affected system. These vulnerabilities were detected in exploits in the wild.
- <u>Apple Releases Multiple Security Updates</u>: Apple released security updates to address vulnerabilities in multiple products. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the <u>Apple Security Updates page</u> and apply the necessary updates.

The CUNA Advocacy Update keeps you on top of the most important changes in Washington for credit union's and what CUNA is doing to monitor, analyze, and influence government agencies and federal law. Issues this week included:
