The [Same Day ACH Payments topic](#) in the [ACH/Electronic Payments channel](#) has been updated to provide additional detail regarding the forthcoming changes to Same Day ACH.

The upcoming enhancements create added opportunities and offerings by providing faster funds availability, expanding access, and increasing dollar thresholds. They will be rolled out in phases, with the first enhancement effective September 20, 2019.

[CFPB Releases Updated Recommendations on Reporting Suspected Elder Financial Abuse](#)

Banks and credit unions are uniquely positioned to detect when an older account holder has been the target or victim of elder financial abuse, and to take action. Today we released an update to our 2016 Advisory for financial institutions on preventing and responding to elder financial exploitation. This Advisory Update focuses on reporting elder financial exploitation (EFE) to appropriate local, state, and federal first responders.

A February 2019 CFPB [report](#) analyzing Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs) on financial exploitation found that most EFE SARs do not indicate that financial institutions reported the suspected abuse to appropriate authorities such as law enforcement and adult protective services. The SARs analysis indicated that elder fraud is widespread and damaging, and underscored that reporting is a key aspect of addressing this abuse. The [2019 Advisory Update](#) provides new information about reporting EFE based on federal and state law changes. This analysis of current laws aims to help financial institutions in their efforts to combat elder fraud.

As a part of the Federal Reserve Banks' continuing commitment to security, they want to remind you of the importance of protecting your organization against cyberattacks. Your organization should ensure your staff receive ongoing training necessary to recognize and report various types of phishing attacks.

[FinCEN Attacks Business Email Compromise Scams on Several Fronts](#)

The Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN) announced new efforts to curtail and impede Business Email Compromise (BEC) scammers and other criminals who profit from their schemes. FinCEN convened another in a series of meetings under its ongoing [FinCEN Exchange](#) forum. The focus was on identifying and combatting potential BEC and resultant money laundering and terrorist financing activities. FinCEN also issued an update to its [Advisory to Financial Institutions on E-mail Compromise Fraud Schemes](#), first published in 2016. The advisory offers updated operational definitions, provides information on the targeting of non-business entities and data by email compromise schemes, highlights general trends in BEC schemes targeting sectors and jurisdictions, and alerts financial institutions to risks associated with the targeting of vulnerable business processes. In addition, FinCEN issued an [in-depth Financial Trend Analysis of BSA data](#) that explores industries targeted and methodologies used by BEC scammers.

These changes may affect U.S. financial institutions' obligations and risk-based approaches regarding relevant jurisdictions. The advisory also reminds financial institutions of the status and obligations involving these jurisdictions, in particular the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) and Iran.

- [Drupal Releases Security Update](#): Drupal released a security update to address a vulnerability in Drupal Core. The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) encourages users and administrators to review Drupal's security advisory [SA-CORE-2019-008](#) and apply the necessary update.
- [Cisco Releases Security Updates for Multiple Products](#): Cisco released security updates to address vulnerabilities in [multiple Cisco products](#). The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the advisories and apply the necessary updates.
- [NCSC Releases 2019 Active Cyber Defence Report](#): The United Kingdom's National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) released their 2019 Active Cyber Defence (ACD) report, which provides an analysis of program outcomes throughout 2018. NCSC's ACD program stood up in 2016, seeks to reduce harm from commodity cyberattacks against the United Kingdom. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review [NCSC's report](#) for more information.
- [Microsoft Releases Security Updates for PowerShell Core](#): Microsoft released updates to address a vulnerability in PowerShell Core versions 6.1 and 6.2. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the [Microsoft Security Advisory](#) and apply the necessary updates.
- [Oracle Releases July 2019 Security Bulletin](#): Oracle released its Critical Patch Update for July 2019 to address 319 vulnerabilities across multiple products. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the Oracle [July 2019 Critical Patch Update](#) and apply the necessary updates.
- [IRS Releases Six Cybersecurity Safeguards](#): The Internal Revenue Service issued a news release outlining six cybersecurity safeguards to protect computers, email, and sensitive data. The recommendations are part of the [Taxes. Security. Together. Checklist](#), which the IRS created to help tax professionals protect sensitive taxpayer data.
- [Google Releases Security Updates for Chrome](#): Google released Chrome 75.0.3770.142 for Windows, Mac, and Linux. This version addresses a vulnerability that an attacker can exploit to take control of an affected system. The CISA encourages users and administrators to review the [Chrome Release](#) and apply the necessary updates.
- [NCSC Releases Advisory on Ongoing DNS Hijacking Campaign](#): The United Kingdom's National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) released an advisory about an ongoing Domain Name System (DNS) hijacking campaign. The advisory details risks and mitigations for organizations to defend against this campaign, in which attackers use compromised credentials to modify the location to which an organization's domain name resources resolve to redirect users, obtain sensitive information, and cause man-in-the-middle attacks.
- [Atlassian Releases Security Updates for Jira](#): Atlassian released security updates to address a vulnerability affecting Jira Server and Jira Data Center. A remote attacker could exploit this vulnerability to take control of an affected system.
